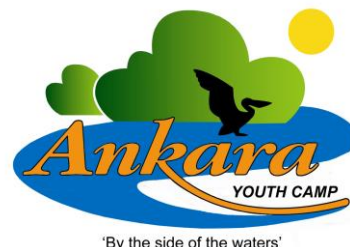


# Information Sheet

## INSURANCE:

- All hirers should have adequate insurance, including public liability

## EMERGENCY INFORMATION:

- Nearest Doctor & Hospital – Mannum – 25 minute drive
- Nearest Public Phone – near Ferry – 200 metres walk
- **Mobile reception – Telstra network gets full service, all others get patchy (if any) reception**
- Emergency calls during camp (or to contact campers) in Dining Room – (08) 8570 8231
- Emergency calls to Ankara Camp Manager – (08) 8570 8043, leave message if no answer

## GENERAL SERVICES:

- Mannum – Butchers, Bakery, Foodland & IGA supermarkets, Garages
- Walker Flat – General stores, Petrol & Diesel – bread & milk deliveries on order

## ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES:

- Times are as stated on Booking Form – please ensure all campers know these times
- Ensure all intended deliveries will occur after your check in time – early deliveries will be refused
- Early arrivals or late departures are by prior written agreement only (subject to previous bookings)
- Please advise if group will arrive 2 hours after set arrival or depart 2 hours before set departure time

## CAMP LEADERS:

- On arrival, complete check-in with the Camp Manager and arrange time for briefing
- Brief campers regarding: drinking water taps, out of bounds areas, sewerage system, water safety rules, emergency equipment and procedures (briefing obtained from Camp Manager)
- Before departure return completed Camp Attendance Folder to Camp Manager
- Before departure Camp Manager to complete check-out procedures; cleaning charges apply if any outstanding items on the In/Out Checklist

## WHAT TO BRING:

- First aid kit, and provide first-aid trained personnel
- Personal belongings – clothing, toiletries, towel, personal needs, insect repellent, torch, swimming attire and old shoes for water activities
- For sleeping – bottom sheet, pillows and all bedding required (mattresses only provided)
- Kitchen – tea towels, wash cloths, dishwashing detergent for sinks
- Extras – whiteboard markers, projector (whiteboard & projector screen provided), PA equipment

## PROVIDED:

- Cooking equipment & utensils, paper towel, matches/gas lighter, disposable hand gloves for cooks
- Detergent for washing machine and commercial dishwasher
- Cleaning supplies, rubbish bags, toilet paper
- Disposable liners for bed-wetters (located on top of cupboard Female Leaders Cabin room C)
- Canoes & PFDs, table tennis tables, tennis/volleyball nets, basketball ring, some sports equipment

## CLEANING:

- For health's sake: daily clean kitchen, dining room, toilets & wash up area (including dishwasher)
- Mop where necessary
- Please keep the grounds tidy during your camp and place all rubbish in bins
- All groups are asked to thoroughly clean the buildings and grounds before departure

## MISCELLANEOUS:

- Campsite is to be quiet by 11.00pm
- No fires to be lit without prior consent of Camp Managers, and no fires on total fire ban days
- Breakages and losses must be reported, replacement charges will apply
